1,600 babies were saved by the first machine that wore out but 98.5% of the mothers who saw the Ultrasound picture had their child.

Br. Ron DeGroot started this initiative from the very beginning. It was with his hard work and untiring effort to follow this effort through many roadblocks that achieved its success. Br. Connerton and Br. Cloninger, in the first picture, from Seattle were very instrumental in getting the initiative through to its dedication.

The Knights and Options are investigating the reasons for this success rate and how to train other ultrasound sites to use these extraordinary positive techniques to achieve these results.
